Sugar Soap Powder



DESCRIPTION

Powafix Sugar Soap can be used as a general household cleaner to remove dirt & grime from baths, basins, sinks, toilets, urinals, wall tiles & vinyl floor tiles. It is perfect for cleaning and preparing surfaces before painting

NORMAL CLEANING

- The normal cleaning solution of Sugar Soap is ideal for standard duty cleaner requirements on all surfaces
- Mixing ratio: dissolve 40 parts water to 1 part Sugar Soap or dissolve ½ cup (12g) of Sugar Soap in 5 Litres of Warm Water

HEAVY DUTY CLEANING

- A stronger Sugar Soap solution is needed to remove accumulated dirt, grease & grime off all exterior & interior painted surfaces: ceramic tiles; face brick; stone facing walls, quarry tiles, oil & grease spillage on garage concrete floors
- Mixing ratio: dissolve 20 parts water to 1 part Sugar Soap or dissolve 1 cup (250g) of Sugar Soap in 5 Litres of warm water
- Rinse off thoroughly with water
- Wash off metal, painted surfaces or plant foliage within 10 minutes

HEAVY DUTY CLEANING

- Add a heaped tablespoon (50g) of Sugar Soap to 2 litres of water to wash paint brushes. This will keep them soft and flexible
- Totally immerse the brushes to clean handles as well as bristles
- Sugar Soap will not attack the glue which adhere the bristles into the stick
- Brushes used for applying oil based primers/undercoats/gloss enamels must first be cleaned with Mineral Turps

- Sugar Soap does not include bleaching components
- Sugar Soap should not be used on aluminium surfaces or bare wood
- Be careful of splashes & spillages on carpets, furniture, wooden surfaces, floors etc.

- Always cover adjacent floor area before using Sugar Soap
- Equipment & hands can be cleaned with Water
